### ***YOUTH CARES to Recognize National Drug Facts Week, November 8-14, 2010***

**November 8-14, 2010** is **National Drug Facts Week** and this year's theme is **Shatter the Myths**. National Drug Facts Week is a health observance week for teens that aims to shatter the myths about drugs and drug abuse. Through community-based events, NIDA is working to encourage teens to get factual answers from scientific experts about drugs and drug abuse.

This year, **YOUTH CARES** (the teen committee of the **Concho Valley CARES Coalition**) is recognizing National Drug Facts Week by having the local SAISD middle and high schools read one drug fact every morning during the announcements throughout the week. YOUTH CARES will end the observance with L8 Nite @ the Lake House a carnival for middle school, high school, and college students.

**L8 Nite @ the Lake House** will take place at the **ASU Lake House**, located on **1925 Beaty Rd**, from **8-11pm**. There will be a \$10 admittance fee for the event which will include a meal and 10 game tickets. Extra game tickets will cost 25 cents each.

Currently, we are still in need of volunteers to host game booths at the event. Due to our limited resources, those who agree to host a game will be responsible for supplying their own materials.

**House of Faith** will provide transportation for teens that need a ride to the event. Three locations throughout the city will be designated pick-up and drop-off spots and they are both Wal-Marts and Lowe's Grocery on Main Street.
