- Team fee: Adult Only Team - \$30, Adult/Youth Team - \$25, Youth Team - \$20
- Team must have name (no team names involving tobacco, alcohol, bars, taverns, & pubs – restaurants okay)
- Team tops must be matching color
- Team must consist of 8 players (6 on court & 2 alternates)
- Minimum age of team member is 10
- Each individual team member must sign waiver
- Each individual team member must sign a promotional release
- Team members under 18 require parental consent
- Team must follow rules and regulations outlined in the rule booklet
- Team must be registered by Friday, March 25, 2011 to ensure they are placed in the tournament bracket
